- ### 1 Aspiration

 - Aspirate medication into syringe as per your usual technique.
 - Reposition safety cover, if necessary, so it does not obscure injection site.
- ### 2 Injection

 - Administer injection according to protocol.
 - For user convenience, the needle "bevel-up" position is oriented to safety cover. (Bevel-up = Safety cover up)
- ### 3 Activation

 - Immediately following injection, activate safety cover by centering thumb or forefinger (of hand holding syringe) on finger pad area of safety cover, then pushing cover forward until you hear/feel it lock.

For use with Luer Lock syringe only.

- Safety activation immediately follows injection
- Audible click indicates safety activation
- Needle remains locked inside activated cover
