

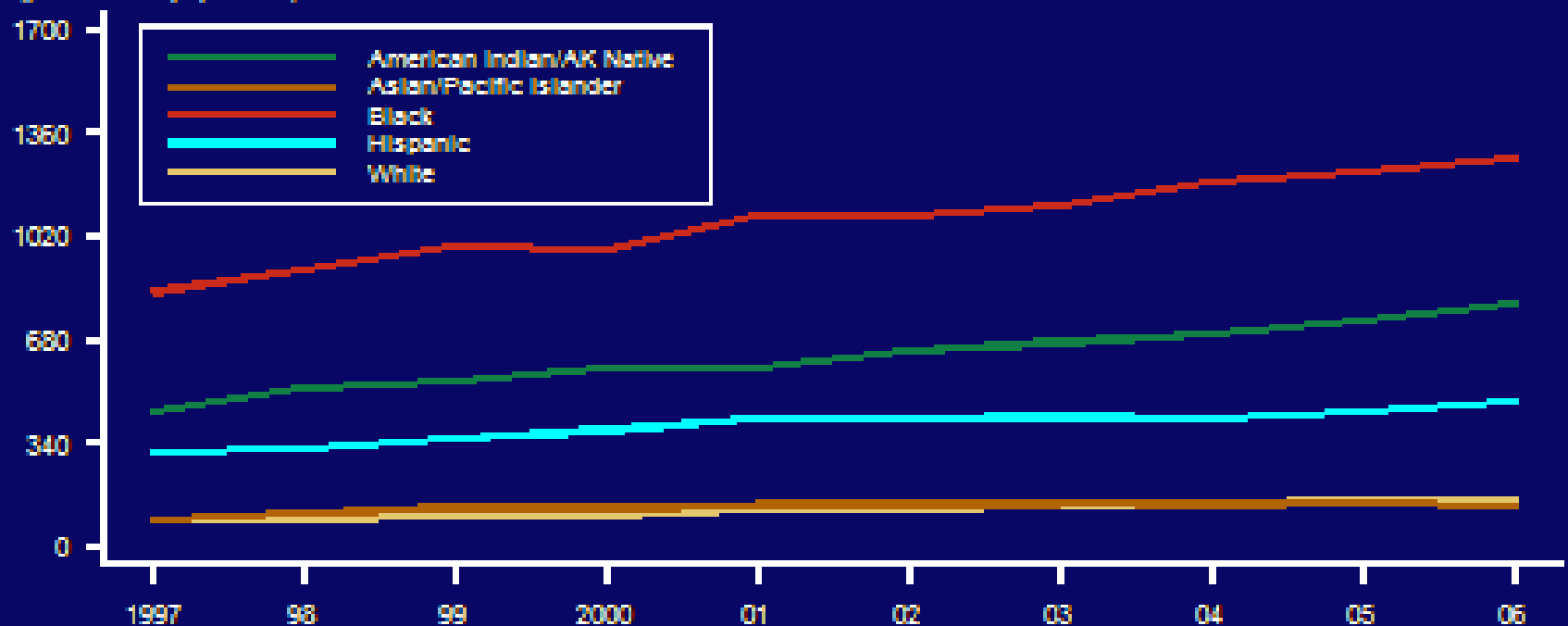

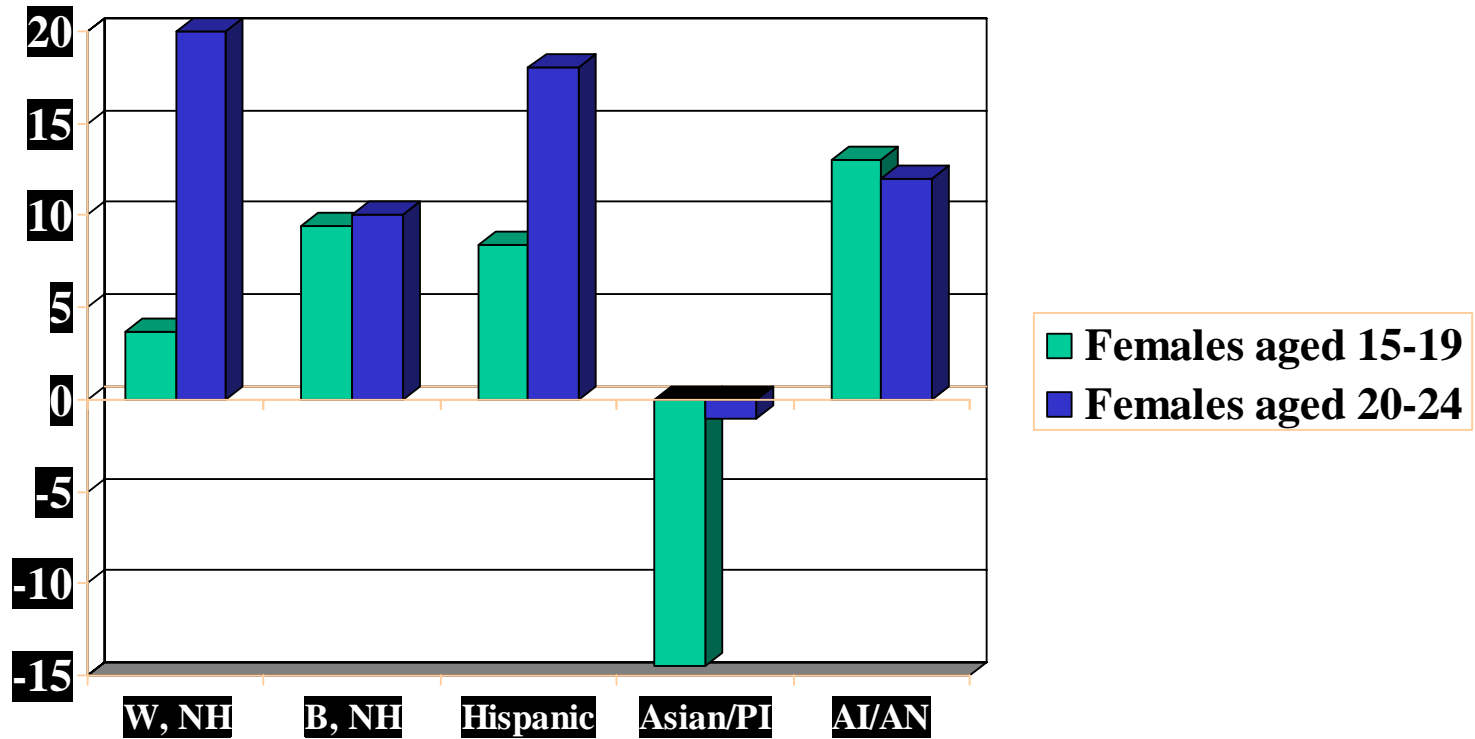

Chlamydia — Rates by race/ethnicity: United States, 1997–2006

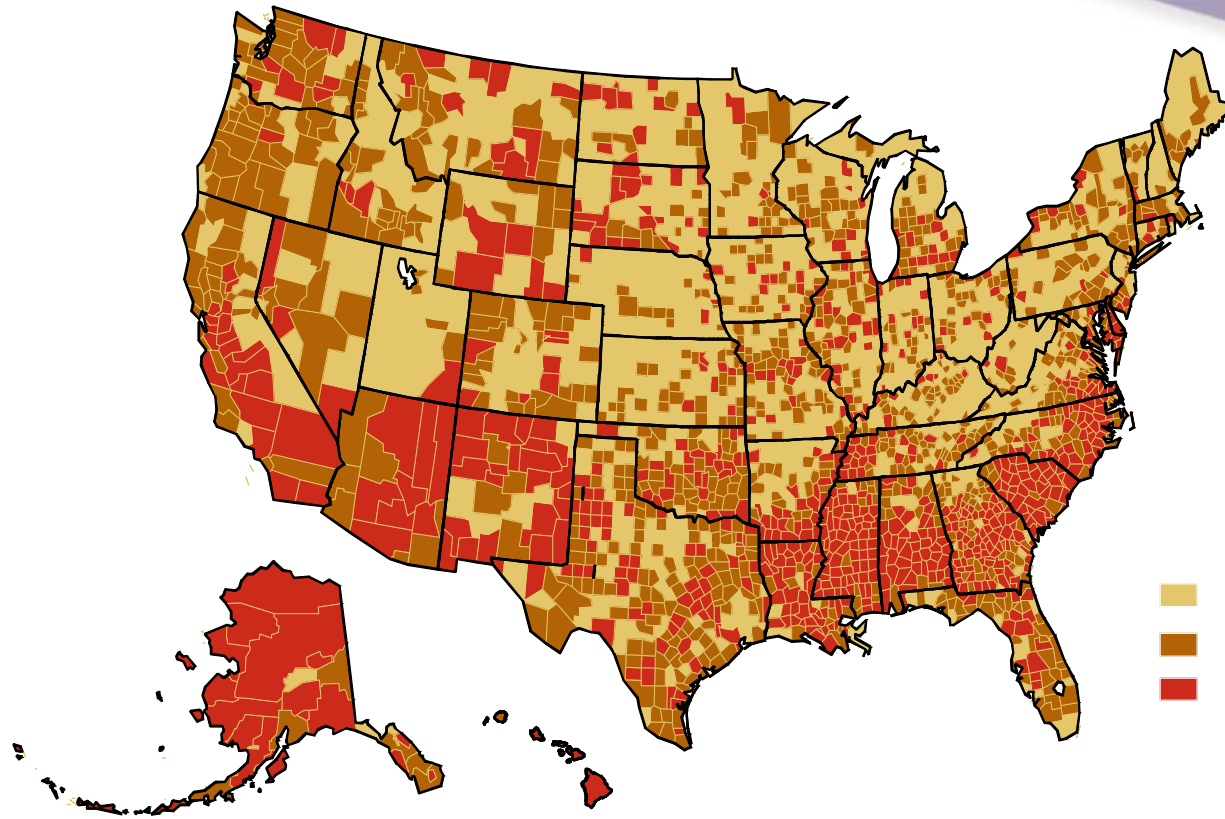
Rate (per 100,000 population)
