1 When to Take Hour Dose

Morning

Lunch

Dinner

Evening

# 2 Injection Technique

No pinch-up technique required.

Inject "straight in," at a 90° angle, flush with skin for easy injection at all sites. Hold the needle in the skin while slowly counting up to 10.



## 3 Site Selection

The no pinch injection technique using 4mm and 5mm pen needles makes it easier to inject in the upper arm and buttocks.


Thigh

## 4 Healthy Injection Practices

Educating patients about good injection technique from the beginning will help them maintain healthier injection sites.

#### **Site Rotation:**

### Always use a new injection site:

Move the place of the injection by about a finger's width from last injection point. Change sites every \_\_\_\_\_ weeks. Gives each injection site the opportunity to recover properly.

#### Reuse:

### Always use a new and sterile needle:

If you reuse a needle, you should be aware that it is no longer sterile. Also, insulin needles are finely ground and lubricated and reuse leads to needle tip damage. Always using a new needle reduces tissue trauma caused by dull, bent or blunt needles.
