# BD Q-Syte<sup>TM</sup> Luer Access Split Septum

## **Points to Practise**







#### **Disinfect**

- Disinfect the silicone septum with an appropriate antiseptic solution.
- Disinfect prior to each access.
- Allow to dry.








#### **Access**

#### Syringe:

- Access the BD Q-Syte device with an ISO luer lock or luer slip syringe.
- Connect ensuring vertical alignment.



#### **Administration Set:**

• When using an administration set insert the luer slip tip into the BD Q-Syte device, then secure the connection.

Note: Do not use needles or blunt cannula with the BD Q-Syte device.



### **Blood Withdrawal:**

• Use ISO syringe or BD Luer-Lok™ access device.









#### Flush

- Flush according to facility policy or until device is clear.
- To minimise reflux of blood into the vascular access device it is recommended to keep pressure on the syringe plunger upon clamping and disconnecting.
- When disconnecting, hold the BD Q-Syte device firmly to the hub to prevent accidental removal.

Be aware that oral syringes can be misconnected to some needleless devices.

The BD Q-Syte™ Device is a closed system to help prevent micro-organisms entering the fluid pathway.
