### Active ingredient

Iodine 2% v/v, USP

### Purpose

Antiseptic

**Use** Patient preoperative skin preparation. Helps to reduce bacteria that potentially can cause skin infection.

## Warnings

For external use only.

### Do not use

- in the eyes
- on patients with known allergies to ethyl alcohol or iodine

**When using this product** keep out of eyes, ears, and mouth

**Stop use and ask a doctor if** irritation, sensitization, or allergic reaction occurs. You may report side effects to FDA at 1-800-FDA-1088.

**Keep out of reach of children.** If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

## Directions

- remove the applicator wrapper. Do not touch the applicator tip.
- with the applicator tip facing downward, pinch the barrel of the applicator ONCE to release the antiseptic.
- press the applicator tip against the patient's skin. With gentle back and forth actions apply solution to the treatment area.
- the area covered should be allowed to dry naturally.
- discard after single use.
